Tomorrow, 4/9/08, San Francisco will host the Olympic Torch Relay beginning at the Giants Ball Park, along Embarcadero and finishing at Justin Herman Plaza across from the Ferry Building. Many hours of planning has gone into the visit and we are hoping for good results. Please keep in mind that traffic along the King Street exit of 280, along the Embarcadero, through Fisherman's Wharf and back at the Justin Herman Plaza will be significantly impacted from as early as 10 AM through 4 PM.

Last Saturday's Human Rights Torch Relay went well with several hundred people at Union Square, up to 100 runners and the finish and gathering back at Union Square. On Wednesday there are noon time protests at Portsmouth and Washington Square's.

4/2/08- 8:37 AM- Post/Hyde- Officer Kim Koltzoff responding to complaints of drugs being sold in the area, initiated contact with an individual who gave her a fake name. Officer Koltzoff investigated and found the man's true identity, an active Burglary warrant and after searching him, located suspected methamphetamine.

4/4/08-3 AM- at Bush and Larkin Streets- Plainclothes Officers Damien Fahey and Kevin Worrell, working prostitution operations, arrested a woman for soliciting acts of prostitution. The woman, dressed in mini skirt and knee length boots, despite frigid temps, also **had outstanding criminal warrants for five counts of Public Nuisance and five counts of soliciting acts of prostitution**. She was booked, rather than cited.

4/4/08- 7 PM- Officer Eric Letsch and Officer Nico Discenza responded to the 700 block of Leavenworth regarding a suspect selling drugs. The suspect was detained and was found to be a Sex Offender who had failed to register. The suspect also had an outstanding warrant and was in possession of a 'crack pipe.'

On 4/5/08 at 5:38 PM, Officer Gary Moriyama was on patrol at Powell and Greenwich when he noticed an individual driving erratically. The officer initiated a car stop and found that the suspect had an outstanding warrant and probation search condition. The officer asked for back up and conducted a search. The officer retrieved considerable amounts of methamphetamine, glass smoking pipes, syringes, suspected marijuana and in a Curious George lunchbox, weight scales. The considerable amounts indicated that the officer had broken up a sales operation.

4/8/08- 00:35 AM- Plainclothes officers Martin Garay and Steve Hogan worked the prostitution operation at Post and Larkin. The officers spotted a woman, provocatively dressed, flagging down vehicles. One motorist pulled over and seemed to strike a deal. The officers moved in and arrested both suspects and recovered suspected crack cocaine from the driver.
