Once on scene they saw a juvenile that matched the 12-year-old who was reported to have brandished a gun. The juvenile was detained and during a pat search a fully loaded .22 caliber revolver was recovered. The juvenile's mother was notified and the juvenile was transported to Bayview Station. A YGC Probation Officer was notified and Officer Olson was told that the juvenile would not be taken in at YGC. The YGC Probation Officer told Officer Olson to contact CARC. The CARC Probation Officer told Officer Olson to cite the juvenile to his parents. The juvenile was cited to his parents with a court date at YGC. The revolver was booked at Bayview Station.

Officers Hastings, Fowler, Norris, and Whitfield responded to an address on Dartmouth regarding a battery incident. Upon arrival the officers saw the victim holding his lower back. The victim told the officers that his boyfriend had hit him and was still in the house. Due to the fact that the victim was having difficulty breathing, paramedics transported the victim to Kaiser. The victim told Officer Hastings that the suspect arrived home at approximately 10:30pm. The suspect got upset because the victim had food on the table. The suspect can not eat after 6:00pm due to health reasons. The suspect told the victim to put the food away. The victim began putting the food in the refrigerator and the suspect punched the victim in the back of his head with his closed right fist. The victim fell to the ground and the suspect kicked the victim in the back approximately ten times. The suspect was arrested, served with an Emergency Protective Order, and booked at Bayview Station. The victim was treated at Kaiser Hospital.
