### Accident Frequency

The department just released the annual statistics regarding those intersections where injury and fatal accidents occurred in 2004 with the

"greatest frequency." Of the top 35 such intersections in the city, only

one of them is in the Bayview, and it is at Bayshore and Silver. There were five reported injury accidents at this intersection in 2004, and we

will focus our enforcement efforts there in 2005 in an effort to reduce these accidents.

## Crime and Enforcement Update

Illegal Lodging, 1400 Custer, March 15 10:00 a.m.

Bayview Officer Remedios responded to 1400 Custer on the call of a homeless

encampment and found a tent surrounded by numerous shopping carts and debris which completely blocked the sidewalk. The person in the tent

admonished regarding her encampment (she had no prior history). At 12:24

a series of tarps and surrounded the tarps with shopping carts, debris, and

Mendell for living in a trailer on a public street.

Carjacking with a Gun, 100 block Nichols, march 15, 12:26 p.m. Bayview officers interviewed a man who told them that he was parking his

car when a suspect jumped in front of the car and pointed a handgun at  $\mbox{him.}$ 

The suspect ordered the victim out of the car and then drove away in the  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{L}}$ 

victim's car. The victim didn't notify police immediately and found his

own car two hours later. The suspect is a black male, 18 to 20 years of

age, armed with a handgun (050 291 083).

Suspicious Acts Toward Child, 2184 Revere, March 15, 2:08 p.m. Bayview Officers Festa and Cruz responded to a home on Revere and spoke with the male caller who stated that on March 12 a friend of his was visiting at his home and he (the caller) became tired and went to bed, leaving his friend watching TV with his 5 and 14 year old daughters. The

caller was awakened by his 14 year old daughter who had caught the friend

exposing himself to the 5 year old daughter and attempting to perform a lewd act with her. The friend was confronted by the caller and left the  $\,$ 

premises. The case has been referred to our Juvenile Unit and an  $\mbox{\ arrest}$ 

warrant is pending (050 292 655).

Warrant Arrest, 85 Cashmere, March 15, 4:05 p.m.

Bayview Officers Reynoso and Dockery were on patrol when they had occasion

to contact a man, living in Richmond, who was wanted for an outstanding warrant. The man was arrested and booked for the warrant (041 168 148)

Domestic Violence, 117 Santos, March 15, 4:30 p.m.

A woman walked into Bayview Station and reported that her ex-boyfriend had

called her on the phone and told her that he was going to "...put a hit on

you..." The victim stated that she used to live with the suspect, and they have one child in common, but they haven't lived with each other for

Aggravated Assault, 3rd and Newcomb, March 15, 10:11 p.m. Bayview officers were attempting to break up a street fight at 3rd and Newcomb when one of the combatants became aggressive toward the officers

and began approaching them in a threatening manner. The man then told the

officers, "You better get out of my face," and began swinging his arms at

the officers. The man was eventually controlled and arrested, but as he

was being taken into custody he head-butted a nearby wall and the officers

called for medical assistance. The man refused to cooperate with paramedics and had to be strapped down to a gurney. The man, living on

the 2100 block of Jennings, has a long history of violent behavior against

both police officers and others, and was booked for aggravated assault and  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{S}}$ 

battery on a peace officer (050 293 556).

Auto Burglary Arrest, 306 Salinas, March 16, 12:06 a.m. Bayview Officers Foss and Bernal responded on the report of an auto burglary in progress and saw two men walking away from a vehicle with a broken out side window. The officers detained the men and then found a third man hiding in the rear seat area of the auto. The owner of the auto

was contacted and responded to the scene, verifying that the suspect had no  $\,$ 

permission to be inside the vehicle. The suspect, living on the 1000 block

of Palou, was booked for auto burglary. The additional two men were identified and released  $(050\ 293\ 750)$ .
