Crime and Enforcement Update

On January 7, at 8:30pm Officers responded to the 900 block of Rutland regarding a sexual battery. Officers were following up and attempting to serve and emergency protective order when they observed the suspect. The suspect was served with the order and was booked on the sexual battery charges. At 3:15pm on the 7th at Newcomb and Newhall officers arrested a total of six individuals for conspiracy and possession of marijuana for sale. Officers had witnessed a marijuana sale and moved in on the individuals. They detained the suspects and found them to be on probation and in possession of a substantial amount of marijuana, some labeled "club marijuana." They were transported to Bayview Station for booking. During the booking officer found on suspect had on his person, in his shoe, a loaded semi-auto pistol. He was booked accordingly. He was released from

jail on the 6th of January and for his birthday on the 7th, he went back to jail. (050072213)

On January 7th at 2:45pm Officers responded to the 1400 block of Newcomb on a report of vandalism. When officers arrived they observed the suspect and detained her. The suspect broke the front door and then threw a brick and the victim. She then broke seven windows throwing a brick at each of them. She was eventually arrested and booked. She has been harassing the victim for the past two weeks since their breakup. The same suspect was booked a few weeks ago for firearm violations just down the block. (050025111)

On the 7th at about 4pm on the unit block of Apollo a robbery occurred. A grandson wanted money from his grandmother and when she refused he went to her purse. She attempted to retain the last of her currency when the suspect slapped her and pushed her to the ground. He took off with the goods. The officers didn't stop there.
