### Crime and Enforcement Update

**Attempted Robbery with Force 2/21/05 @ 5:19 p.m., Cashmere St**  
Officers responded to the 200 block of Cashmere Street where the victim reported that he was walking to his car, which was parked in front of his house, when a man approached him and asked him if he could use his cell phone. The victim refused and the man swung at him. The victim defended himself and chased the suspect away. The suspect fled on foot north on Cashmere Street. (Case # 050 203 044)

**Robbery with a Gun 2/21/05 @ 9:21 p.m., 3rd St. & Revere**  
A man was parked at Revere and 3rd and was displaying three laptop computers that he wished to sell to the suspects. After checking out the laptops, the suspects started running away while still carrying the laptops. The victim drove around the corner in order to follow the suspects, and when the victim confronted one of the suspects, the suspect pointed a gun at the victim and then fled (Case # 050 204 008).

**Warrant Arrest 2/22/05 5:12 a.m., Lane & Newcomb Streets**  
Officers observed a double parked vehicle with no license plates on the north side of Newcomb. The officers then saw a man lean into the window of the car and speak with two individuals seated in the front seat. When the officers attempted to approach the vehicle, the driver took off at a fast speed. The officers caught up with the suspect and a computer search revealed that the suspect had a \$20,000.00 warrant for his arrest (Case # 050 204 519).

Cocaine, Methamphetamine, Warrant Arrest 2/22/05 @ 8:50 a.m., West Point Rd  
Plainclothes officers while driving their unmarked vehicle saw an adult male urinating in public. As the officers approached the man, they recognized him as someone on felony probation for weapons. A second man came out of the building and was also recognized by officers to be the first suspect's brother. The officers saw the second suspect discard something on the ground, and after searching the area, the officers found a zip lock bag of cocaine and another zip lock bag containing methamphetamine in the second suspect's pants pocket. The first suspect was cited for urinating in public. The second suspect was booked (Case # 050 204 826).

Cocaine, Base/Rock, Possession For Sale, Heroin, Possession for Sale 2/22/05 9:33 a.m., 3rd St

Officers witnessed two suspects standing on the northwest corner of 3rd and McKinnon involved in what appeared to be a drug transaction. When the suspects saw the police, one of them put an object into her mouth. The officers quickly approached the two suspects and searched them, finding cocaine base, small balloons containing heroin, and a crack pipe (Case # 050 204 989).

Cocaine, Base/Rock, Possession For Sale; Marijuana Offense 2/22/05 @ 10:22 a.m., Kirkwood St Plainclothes Officers spotted a man sitting in a parked vehicle without license plates on the 1500 block of Kirkwood St. The officers approached the vehicle and saw several marijuana cigars on the center console. Officers arrested the suspect for possession of marijuana. When the suspect was searched, officers found a large quantity of cocaine base in the suspect's pant's pocket (Case # 050 204 945).

Domestic Violence, Aggravated Assault 2/22/05 @ 2:35 p.m., 130 Kiska Rd  
Officers responded regarding an assault. A female victim was outside screaming and told the officers that her boyfriend had locked her out of the house and had thrown a bottle at her head. The female victim gave officers the house keys and the officers entered the house. The man then climbed onto the roof of the building to avoid arrest. Inside the house, the officers saw five baggies of marijuana on the table and then saw the victim take the marijuana and put it in her jacket pocket.
