Crime and Enforcement Update

On December 20th, a mother and child came to Bayview Station to report suspected child abuse. All the necessary agencies were notified as well as our Juvenile Bureau.

On the 20th, officer responded to the 1400 block of Thomas on a report of a juvenile with an outstanding warrant. The officer found the juvenile and transported him to YGC and booked him for his battery warrant.
