Milton Meyer Activities

Crime and Enforcement Update

On December 18th Officers were in the area of the unit block of Westpoint road. They observed a vehicle run a stop sign and then screech the tires as it went around the island. There were about six pedestrians in the area at this time. A traffic stop was effected and the driver exited the car. Officers tried to order the driver to get back in the vehicle but he refused and began running. A foot chase ensued and the officers ordered the suspect to stop many times. The suspect was arrested within five minutes after he ran into an occupied unit. He was found to have on his person several baggies of marijuana. More marijuana and as well as suspected methamphetamine was found in the suspect's jacket that he discarded on the stairs of the apartment. The suspect was booked for possession of marijuana, possession of methamphetamine, resisting the officers, driving w/o a license and reckless driving. (041434024)

At 5:30 PM in the area of the 1600 block of Newcomb officers arrested a person for possession for sale of crack cocaine. This person had been admonished several times about violating section 11532(a) of the Health and Safety Code.

At 4:00am Officers responded to the unit block of Cameron Way on a report of Domestic Violence. The victim told the Officers that her ex-boyfriend in the Mission District assaulted her earlier today. The victim told the officers that her ex slammed her head into the windshield of a car with such force that the windshield broke. Later that day the suspect came back to Cameron way and was arrested. He was booked on domestic violence related offenses and threats. An emergency protective order was issued. (041431973)

At about 10PM on Revere St at third Officers observed a known individual driving a Ford Mustang. The officers knew the suspect had a felony warrant. The officers approached the vehicle and ordered the individual to exit the

vehicle. The driver ignored the officers and sped off. Two officers jumped out of the way as the suspect's vehicle fish-tailed as it sped away. The vehicle was located two minutes later on Third St. with front end damage. The suspect is outstanding at this time. (041434284)

Officer responded to Reddy St on a report of Cruelty to an Animal. There they found that a family pet was dead. They notified Animal care and control who responded and took control of the animal. Family members told officers that the animal was a young friendly dog and was last seen in their backyard. It was possibly kidnapped the night before, killed and then returned to the backyard.
