The victims said that they were about to enter a residence when the five robbers approached them. One of the robbers had a gun and demanded money from the victims and threatened to shoot them. One of the victims spoke with the robbers, and then instructed his daughter to call the police. The robbers then fled.

A short time later, Officer Ferraez received a phone call from one of the victims. The victim said that one of the robbers was across the street. Plainclothes officers responded and detained the robber. A "cold show" was done. The victim identified the captured robber, a juvenile, as one of the five who initially tried to rob him. The four outstanding suspects are described as: Black males, 5'0", 150 lbs., black hair, black shirt. One of the suspects was armed with a handgun.

The woman convinced the ex-boyfriend to drive her back home to get clothes for the daughter. During the drive, the woman told the boyfriend that she was going to call the police. The ex-boyfriend said that he would kill himself if she called the police. The ex-boyfriend eventually left with the 5 year old daughter.

Numerous Bayview Officers responded to the ex-boyfriend's residence. Officers entered the garage a found the ex-boyfriend laying in a pool of blood with an knife in his chest. Officers called for an ambulance and provided medical aid. Other officers searched the residence for the 5 year old daughter. Some of the doors were locked, so the officers forced the doors open. Inside a bedroom, the officers found the 5 year old daughter hiding under a bed. She was unharmed. Officers obtained an Emergency Protective Order for the woman and the daughter. The ex-boyfriend was transported to S.F. General Hospital.
