Crime and Enforcement Update

Possession of a Firearm, 04/19/05 8pm unit blk of Northridge
Officers from the Gang Task Force Unit were in the area of the unit blk of Northridge. They were driving very slowly and when they pulled alongside the suspect, the suspect dropped a firearm to the ground. What was unusual about this arrest was that when the officers were driving, they noticed the suspect was wearing a ski mask. The suspect apparently did not know they were approaching until they were right next to him. He was booked for the carrying a concealed firearm. At the station he admitted that he had found the gun a few days earlier and that he dropped it because he did not want to be shot by the police. (050435841)
