- ◆ Applicable to San Francisco public housing residents on the lease
- ◆ 5 (five) scholarships valued at \$500.00 will be awarded to 5 San Francisco public housing residents on the lease
- ◆ Required to participate in all activities of the Mayor's Graduation for Public Housing Residents event on June 26, 2008 at City Hall
- ◆ Must be planning to enter college in Fall 2008 as a freshman (College must have accreditation from the State of California for Higher Learning) with a minimum of 12 units in courses
- ◆ Must provide proof of College enrollment as full-time student (12 units) when enrolled
- ◆ Required to provide 1st semester or 1st quarter course grades
- ◆ Cumulative GPA 2.5 (must provide proof)
- ◆ Submit a 500 word (minimum words required) "Typed" "Double-Spaced" essay response to this question—"What is the value of a good education?"
