### Public Interest

#### The Department of Child Support Services

The Department of Child Support Services (DCSS), previously a part of The District Attorney's Office, was created through Assembly Bill 196 and Senate Bill 542, in 1999. We are located in downtown San Francisco at 617 Mission Street and New Montgomery Street.

DCSS directly serves over 35,000 children of San Francisco's children residing in the City benefit from our services. We establish and enforce paternity, child support and medical insurance orders. We collect and distribute monies to families.

We pursue interstate reciprocal establishment and enforcement of child support orders in all 50 states, territories and many countries.

November 2003, our Department opened a branch office in the Bayview Hunters Point District, and in February 2002, a satellite office in the Mission-Excelsior Districts. Neighborhood residents can now open a new case or get information on how their case is progressing. We extend free full services at our main and branch offices, but we do not accept payments at the branch offices. Each of our offices has bi-lingual staff. We also have child support officers co-located at the Human Services Agency, 170 Otis Street

### In Summary:

- Department of Child Support Services is no longer part of the District Attorney's Office.
- Child support services are free of charge.
- The offices have bi-lingual Child Support Officers who speak Chinese and Spanish. 8:00 to 5:00 PM, Monday to Friday (open)
- No appointments are necessary at any of our three offices.

and had contact with the driver earlier. The driver was flirting with the witness and gave them his business card. They saw the driver hit the car and sped off the witness approached the victim and gave the information to the victim.

Later that Saturday afternoon, the driver of the Tahoe reported to the South San Francisco Police Department that his car was stolen. The Tahoe was equipped with a tracking device and was quickly found in the Portola District with front end damage and the keys still in it. It was towed with a hold for hit and run. A week and a half later the Tahoe is still in the impound yard waiting for the driver to meet with an Inspector before it gets released.

Monday, May 28, 2007 - 6:34 PM - Robbery w/a Knife - Oakdale Avenue and Third Street - CS# 070 542 026 - Bayview Officers responded to Oakdale Avenue and Third Street regarding a robbery. It was learned that a witness saw a man pull the victim towards him by his shirt and held a knife to the victim's stomach. The area was searched for the victim and the suspect. The victim was found a block away and it was learned that \$300.00 was stolen from him. The witness followed the suspect to an address on McKinnon Avenue.

Three days later, Officers Solares, Lew, Alcaraz, and Benzinger, were in the area of 3rd and Palou Street when they saw a man that matched the description of the robbery suspect. They detained him and learned that he is on parole for robbery and released from prison the beginning of April. His parole officer was contacted who authorized a parole hold.

Monday, May 28, 2007 - 10:37 PM - Aggravated Assault - 3rd Street and Wallace - CS# 070 542 559 - Late this evening, a man was driving down the street with his new girlfriend. A car was following him and honking its horn. The man pulled into a parking lot, and the car following him pulled in behind him, blocking any escape. The man got out of his car and confronted the driver. He saw that it was his ex-girlfriend. The ex-girlfriend demanded to know who the man was with and tried to spray him with pepper spray. The man backed away and his ex-girlfriend put the car in gear and attempted to back over him. Instead she hit the man's car. She pointed her car again at the man but he dove out of the way. She tried one more time to run over the man before she drove off. Fortunately, the man only suffered a cut on his arm when he dove away from the car. The woman is outstanding and a warrant is being issued for her arrest.

the victim did not cooperate with the police numerous witness identified the shooter as a 15-16 year old area resident. They told investigators that the teen fired a rifle into the sidewalk and the bullet ricocheted and struck the girl in the neck. The girl survived this wound and the police are currently looking for the suspect.

Friday, June 1, 2007 - 12:36 AM - Resisting a Police Officer - 1600 Block of Kirkwood - CS# 070 553 813 - A Bayview officer was injured this early morning when attempting to apprehend a person with a felony warrant. Officer Singh and Tierrafria saw the wanted man riding his bike in the area of Newhall Street and Kirkwood Avenue. They approached the man. Officer Tierrafria got out of the car and approached the man. The man began to run. The officers chased the man, Officer Tierrafria on foot and Officer Singh in the police car.

The man threw his bike in the path of Officer Tierrafria causing her to tumble over it. In the process she suffered an injury to her knee. The suspect got away but was apprehended that afternoon without incident. Officer Tierrafria was taken to the hospital and released. She will return to full duty in approximately a month.

Saturday, June 2, 2006 - 10:53 PM - Robbery Series - Potrero Hill - CS# 070 559 689 & 070 559 673 - Two robberies occurred minutes apart and a block apart from one another late Saturday evening. In the first incident a cab driver was robbed at the corner of Kansas and 19th Street, after dropping off a fare. As he was seated in the cab the rear door opened and the suspects got in. They pointed a gun at the cab driver's head and demanded his money.

The second incident occurred just minutes later on Rhode Island and 19th Streets. In this case, a man was getting out of his car when he was approached by the males. They brandished a gun and demanded the victim's wallet.

In both cases the suspects were described as two black males wearing black clothing. The first one is described as short between 20-25 years old. The other suspect is a little bit taller with the same age and clothing. In the first incident the first suspect was wearing a ski mask.

Sunday, June 3, 2007 - 2:40 PM - Graffiti, resisting arrest - Rankin and Custer Street - CS# 070 561 894 - A Norwegian and Canadian man were booked for vandalism and fleeing from the police. In this case the two were a little wet behind the ears in regards to the justice system. Bayview Officers responded to a call of vandals spray painting the side of a building which borders Islais Creek. Islais Creek runs parallel to Cesar Chavez Street into the Bay. The officer arrived on scene and used their

car's loudspeaker and told the vandals to stop. They complied, however they jumped into the creek in attempt to elude capture. They began to swim to the other side of the creek. The officers were able to broadcast a description and direction of travel over the radio. Other officers arrived on scene, as well as the SFPD Marine Unit. The vandals waded to shore and gave up.

They were booked on vandalism charges and fleeing the police. In this case the two suspects were from foreign nations. The graffiti or "tagging" community is online, have chat rooms and message boards that list good places to go put up their wares.
